

Primary Facilitator

group responsibility



Remember you have a 'group responsibility'. Your primary role is to keep every student in the group actively 'engaged'.

eye contact



Make eye contact with and direct your attention to the non-target student. The 'target' student is already actively engaged performing the assigned task.

other tasks



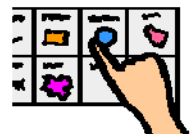
When involved in a group activity, time or labor intensive tasks are always delegated to a Secondary Facilitator.

communicate



You are responsible for creating NCO: numerous communicative opportunities

1-UP



Always try to EXPAND a student's non-verbal and/or verbal communication by reflecting back their message with an added element. Think of 1-UP.

equal



Devote 'equal time' to all students regardless of their level of functioning.

You are so smart



Saying "You are so smart!" "Great Idea!" or "I knew you knew that!" maintains the intrinsic flow of the message. Labeling comments as "Good talking" just doesn't make sense. Would you ever say that to any one else?
